I would also like to thank the exhibitors for their entries and allowing me the privilege of judging their dogs. I was very pleased to see that my Dog CC, Bitch CC, RDCC and Best Puppy all had the same sire. BOB - Elders' Enryb Skye Blue. DCC - Byrne's Ch Enryb Simply Red - CC. Res DCC - Sweeney's Redrafi Mrembo Nacho - RCC. BCC - Elders' Enryb Skye Blu. Res BCC - Edminson's Kisdon Happy Memories. BP - Sweeney's Redrafi Mrembo Nacho - RCC. BV - Summerfield's Ambermoore Tanzanite Blue At Miadsc. Best Sp Beginner - Johnston's Lovely Luna For Rosettaberry TAF NAF.

MPD (1) 1 Gray's Zoldmali Bolero (Imp Srb). At just 7 months old this young dog is well up to size but is balanced for height to length ratio. Well boned, neat feet, straight forelegs with enough brisket for age. Unfortunately, he lacks almost all trace of wire coat with only a very few hairs here and there, and very little facial furnishings. He was very erratic on the move.

PD (2) 1 Sweeney's Redrafi Mrembo Nacho. RCC. Really liked this quality young boy, so typical in outline, he has a super masculine head of correct proportions with a soft and gentle expression. He is completely balanced fore and aft, strong top line, correct tail set, body proportions developing nicely for his age. Moves out with accuracy and plenty of drive. I could not deny him BP & RDCC and pleased to see him awarded PG3. 2 Gray's Zoldmali Bolero (Imp Srb). Repeat of MPD.

PGD (2) 1 Whiting's Navarro Del Fatalbecco At Cragvallie (Imp Ita). 3 year old and who's size I preferred to second, good forequarters, well ribbed back. Level topline, good depth of chest, well made hindquarters. Very erratic on the move. 2 Clymer & Clymer's Phantomfuror Guava. Quite a tall dog and whose head and expression I preferred to winner, he has a good coat and plenty of facial furnishings, he is lacking in forechest, he tends to give his handler a hard time but once stood he has a strong topline and once he settled on the move he has plenty of drive.

LD (4, 1) 1 Summerfield's Miadsc Cast A Spell. 20 month old youngster of good breed type, head still needs to break but is of correct proportions with kind eye and good facial furnishings. Straight forelegs with good bone and tight feet. Would just prefer a little more length of neck and a slightly better lay of shoulder. Developed chest with good spring of rib, strong topline, correct tail set and once settled moves very sound both coming and going. 2 Thomas' Hosokter Tompa At Odinsmoke. 5 year old who was presented in super musculature, he is longer cast than winner and tended to drop his topline at times. He has good bone, well made hindquarters, moved well, again another one who was lacking facial hair. 3 Whiting's Zoldmali Iszkiri At Cragvallie (Imp Serb).

OD (5) 1 Byrne's Ch Enryb Simply Red. CC. At nearly 3 years old this dog is of good size, I see that he is a full Champion which confirms why he was presented in such fit hard condition. Super make and shape, masculine head with correct shape and eye colour, lovely soft expression, excellent forequarters, good

strong bone and feet, strong topline, well muscled hindquarters, harsh wire coat with undercoat. He excels on the move, covering the ground, with excellent drive from his strong hindquarters. DCC. 2 Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal. Another quality dog with an impressive outline, super head and expression, he has good body proportions with well sprung ribs and firm loin. Balanced quarters fore and aft. Presented in good condition and correct wire coat, preferred the movement of winner today. 3 Whitney's Enryb True Blue.

SBB (1) 1 Johnston's Lovely Luna For Rosettaberry TAF NAF. Very feminine 14 month young bitch who is still quite raw at the moment, everything is in the right place, she just needs time to develop. Very pleasing head with correct skull to muzzle proportions and very gentle expression. Her coat is a little woolly, she has a strong top line and correct tail set, she was handle very well and on the move was true both coming and going. BSB.

MPB (1) 1 Busby's Starshot Hawkeye. 8 month old roly poly baby who is well of for bone, she is very outgoing, pretty head with super expression and good furnishings, she can tend to stand a little wide in front. Once she settles she moves ok.

PB (2) 1 Edminson's Kisdon Happy Memories. At just 11 months old this young lady has a very impressive outline and is so full of quality and type. She has a super outgoing temperament and she made me smile every time I looked at her as she never stopped wagging her tail. Feminine head with the cheekiest of expressions, super forequarters with good bone and feet and is totally balanced throughout. For one so young, she is so accurate on the move fore and aft with near perfect footfall and true ground covering movement with plenty of reach and drive. BPB & RBCC. 2 Wearing's Venum Ventulus Hanga At Genlusa (Imp) NAF TAF. A finer built puppy of nearly 12 months, pretty head with gentle expression, she is just lacking furnishings and just a little narrow in foreface. She is of good overall shape and moved well.

JB (4) 1 Newman's Morganna Anise. 14 month old quality bitch, she was presented in good harsh wire coat and has the desired furnishings. Excellent body proportions, balanced angulation fore and aft, her handler tends to overstretch her at times and she tends to drop her top line, she is extremely well muscled and on the move she has plenty of reach and drive. 2 Sweeney's Naughty Niffler By Redrafi TAF NAF. Another 14 month old young lady, she is well up to size but is balanced for height to length ratio. Good head and expression, clean neck with well laid shoulders, she still needs to develop in her chest. Strong topline leading to well made hindquarters. Excellent movement both fore and aft and when viewed in profile. 3 Connolly's Bardantop Witchway Benmorby.

YB (2) 1 Richardson's Tragus Flirty Fox. 19 month old bitch who is very feminine in outlook, lovely head and the softest of expressions, clean muscled neck into good forequarters level topline which she retains at all times, ribs well back, good coat texture, moved very soundly. 2 Newman's Morganna Anise. Repeat of JB.

NB (1) 1 Sweeney's Redrafi Little Governor. At nearly 4 years old this young lady stood alone in this class, she is extremely well schooled and is of a pleasing overall size and shape. Lovely head of good proportions kind oval eye and good furnishings, she can tend to stand a little wide in front. Moved very well covering the ground well and holding her strong topline at all times.

PGB (6, 2) 1 Bendikas & Bendikas' Holsan Lenti. 3 year old of bitch who is built on a larger frame, pleasant head and expression, strong neck, deep chest, good strong body proportions, presented in harsh wire coat, well muscled throughout. Very sound on the move. 2 Lewis' Adel Liliana. Another 3 year old who is finer all through, fine appealing head and soft expression. Balanced angulation fore and aft, level top line and good tail set, she just has a little too much tuck up. Presented in good harsh wire coat. Moved very well at one with handler. 3 Court's Twelveoaks Carolina Red.

LB (6, 1) 1 Elders' Enryb Skye Blue. At just 19 month old this bitch stood out in this class, she is so full of breed type and is totally balanced throughout. Loved her head and soft gentle expression. Clean strong neck leading to excellent forequarters, level topline, which she retains both stood and on the move. Good depth and width of chest, well ribbed back into strong loin, moderate and muscled hindquarters. Presented in fabulous condition and coat, she really excels on the move and she is so sound and true, with excellent reach and drive. CC & BOB and pleased to see that she was shortlisted in the Group. 2 Moss' Enryb Scarlett O'hara At Ewtor. Nearly 3 years old and I notice has the same breeding as the winner from an earlier litter. She is presented in perfect coat, has a lovely head and expression, she just tended to dip in the topline and I preferred the front construction of winner. She moved very well in profile. 3 Cooper's Deifstock Desert Rose.

OB (2) 1 Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Honey Bee. 5 year old and another quality bitch, lovely make and shape with good overall balance. Feminine head and soft expression, clean neck into good forequarters, level top line and length of ribcage, muscled hindquarters. Moved very well. Good coat presentation with a harsh wire jacket. 2 Riley & Riley's Fassfields Like A Baroness. Another 5 year old bitch who is of good make and shape she is a little finer in head but has the furnishings, clean neck into good forequarters, presented in super muscle tone and excellent coat. She is a free and easy mover with plenty of reach and drive.

VB (3, 1) 1 Summerfield's Ambermoore Tanzanite Blue At Miadsc. 8 year old bitch presented in outstanding muscled condition, she is so full of breed type and is totally balanced throughout. Pleasing head with lovely expression, clean neck into correct lay of shoulder, strong topline, correct tail set. Moves extremely well both fore and aft and with plenty of reach and drive. BV. 2 Wearing's NL Ch NL CH Zoldmali Anizs At Genlusa SGWC. 9 year old and another who is also well muscled, she was just carrying a little weight over the loin, super head and expression, not as strong in topline as winner, good angulation fore and aft. She is very sound on the move.
