Good to judge the breed again. Type is still mixed but coats generally good and some very good movers.

PD (2) 1 Harris' Fitzrovia Take A Chance. 7 months puppy full of breed type and with an excellent coat. Well constructed and a really good mover at both ends. Carrying a little puppy fat at the moment which just shows in his topline but I liked him enormously and think he will do well. BP.

JD (2) 1 Harris' Fitzrovia Gideons Way. 15 months, clean in outline with excellent coat. He needs to drop in chest and fill out generally. Good for reach in front, a little close behind. Masculine head of good proportions. 2 Sweeney's Redrafi Mrembo Nacho. 13 months, heavier all through, good proportions and deep chest. Not the forehand construction of winner. Good drive. Head and bone are a little overdone for my taste.

PGD (1) 1 Whiting's Navarro Del Fatalbecco At Cragvallie. 3 year old at the lower end of the size scale but balanced and typy. He has a masculine head of good proportions, good ribcage and good shoulder giving forward reach. Coat is quite good but could be better presented.

LD (8, 1) 1 Summerfield's Miadsc Cast A Spell. 22 months, excellent size and proportions and very good coat. His croup is a little steep which detracts from his outline but won this class on accuracy on the move. Good head proportions and shape. 2 Whitney's Enryb True Blue. 20 months. I liked his proportions and outline very much and he has a better croup and tail set but he needs firm up on the move. Stronger head than the winner but free of coarseness. A lot of type. 3 Allison's Fitzrovia Gone With The Wind.

OD (7, 2) 1 Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal. 6 year old, masculine without coarseness and immaculate on the move at both ends. He has maximum substance for my taste but he is full of type, good head proportions and soft expression. Accurate and scopey on the move. CC and later BOB but pushed hard by 2, Deighton's Furlums Tavaszi. 4 year old, pressed hard, athletic, slightly lighter frame than the winner and excellent quality and type all through. Lovely to watch in profile. Excellent head. Great profile stride. Not quite as finished in front as the winner but I was very impressed by him. Lovely coat and holds a good topline RDCC. 3 Coxhead's Zoldmali Lipton At Brecalde.

VD (5, 1) A good class. 1 Allison's Monkstrod Hornet. 13 year old amazing dog, full of type and still wonderfully sound and scopey on the move. Clean and complete dentition as were all in this class. BV. 2 Lyharr Flavio Akos For Bonisla. 8 years old, finer boned dog with superb coat. He is very accurate at both ends but not the scope on the move. Fine head, a touch longer in foreface but he is a lovely dog in great condition. 3 Howard's Lanokk Szivos JW.

PB (1) 1 Byrne's Aldofovolyi-Drotos Csermely At Enryb. 10 months with excellent proportions and outline and accurate at both ends on the move. Ribcage a little short. Good head proportions. Good topline held on the move. Needs a touch more confidence and this shows in her carriage.

JB (9, 2) 1 Newman's Morganna Anise. Lovely bitch of 15 months who has a lot of type. I'd prefer a touch more leg for balance but her accurate movement and good coat and good head proportions appealed greatly. Can fill out a little to help her topline. Pressed very hard for RCC. Best Junior. 2 Connolly & Guest's Bardantop Witchway Benmorby. 17 months, loved the proportions of this bitch who has a wonderful wire coat. At the moment she is a leggy teenager but should finish very well. 3 Johnston's Lovely Luna For Rosettaberry.

YB (1) 1 Moss' Ewtor Guilty As Sinn. 23 months, feminine head and good expression. Her front needs to tighten. Good drive. A real adolescent on the move. Coat not at its best. PGB (4, 2) Difficult choice between two very different bitches. 1 Bendikas Holsan Lenti. 3-year old top size and a touch long for balance but she has a good head, excellent coat, holds her topline on the move and was the better mover here. 2 Heslop's Nordicwalker Wild Solitude At Bonisla. 3 years old at the lower end of the size scale and carrying too much weight. I preferred her for size and proportions but she insisted on pacing. When she got going looked a good bitch, needs less weight and more ring training.

LB (5, 2) 1 Cooper's Deifstock Desert Rose. 2 year old, stood out here. Lovely size and balance and an excellent coat. Scopey and sound on the move. Correct proportions, balance and unexaggerated angulation. Head is feminine but a little light. However, in the challenge her movement and balance and topline made her a convincing BCC winner – her second. 2 Elders' Enryb Skye Blue. 20 months, a teenager in the body but good on the move and a very pleasing head. 3 Connolly's Bardantop Rumbaba With Benmorby.

OB (9, 6) Apologies, brief notes made in the rain. 1 Edminso's Sh Ch Kisdons Custom Made. 6 year old quality bitch scoring on the move to win this class. Good head and expression. Has a lot of breed qualities but in the challenge I preferred the proportions of the Limit winner. Res BCC, pressed very hard by the Junior Bitch. 2 Upton's Tragus Honey Bee JW. 5 year old, feminine balanced bitch whose proportions I liked. Not moving well today or holding her topline, the weather at this point meant that we had to go indoors and she was not enjoying the conditions. 3 Byrne's Aldofovolyi-Drotos Nyuzsgo At Enryb JW.

VB (3) 1 Summerfield's Ambermoore Tanzanite Blue At Miadsc ShCM. 8 years, typey bitch with lovely head, coat and proportions. A little low set-in tail which detracts from her outline. Good front action, a little close in rear. Has many qualities which I have liked in the past. 2 Wearing's NI Ch Zoldmali Anizs At Genlusa. 9 years, a good moving bitch with good coat and quality head, she was soft in topline on the day but has a lot of type. 3 Guest's Bardantop Plum Duff.

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
