However, from those present it is evident that breeders are conscious of conformation and sound structure. This is a robust maid or all work in the field, with a protective coat and as such needs to be sound in all departments in order to fulfil it's function as a working gundog. I thank the exhibitors for giving me the pleasure of going over their charges especially on such a weather adverse day.

JD (1) 1 Pugh's Zoldmali-Hunter Erme. Ideal type with typical head and expression. Presented moderate angles but these will change as he matures. Up to size in good coat and moved well.

LD (2) 1 & RCC Collier's Belatarr America. Grand dog, up to size he excelled in skull proportions and expression. Ideal fore hand assembly strong firm top line standing and on the move, Balanced rear angles, well off for bone and sound on the mover. 2 West's Junetta Dorjan. A smart dog presenting a typical outline. Good skull proportions, kind expression. I preferred the angles on winner.

OD (1) 1 & DCC Byrne Ch Enryb Simply Red. A lovely dog built on classic lines, typical and balanced all through with the best of angulation fore and aft. He excelled in skull proportions, clean and lengthy neck, first top lind and correct underline. In excellent coat and sound on the move.

VD (1) 1 Collier's Belatarr North By Northwest Sh.CM. A dog I have admired over his show career and he still impresses me. 7 years young a smart dog in excellent coat. Typical and balanced all through, ideal angles fore and aft and still sound on the move. SBD/B (2,1) 1 Zoldmali-Hunter Erme

MPB (2) 1st: BPB & BP. Cooper's Hazean Donetsk to Deifstock (IKC) Presented a typical and balanced outline, excelled in skull proportions and ecxpression. On a sound front and good feet, moderate angles fore and aft and sound on the move. 2 Nokes' Goldpaw Five to Midnight. Very close to winner and could change places at any time. I just preferred the couples on winner.

PGB (4,1) 1 Nokes Trebus Tanselle At Goldpaw. She presented a typical outline, skull, neck and the best for and rear angulation in this class. Level, strong top line standing and on the move. Correct underline and sound and true on the move. 2 Reed's Bardantop Sticky Toffee with Cuffnells. Close up to winner, I just preferred the hind action of winner. 3 Gibbs' Venatordream Illinois avec Benonton

LB (3) 1 & RCC Newman Morganna Anise. Lovely, quality bitch presenting a clear, balanced and typical outline. In excellent coat, correct angulation fore and aft, level top line, correct couples and tail set. Well ribbed up and very sound and true on the move. 2 Smillie-Gray's Oakberrow M'Lady Gin. Enough of her and presented a typical and balanced outline, ideal fore hand assembly, top line, croup and hind quarters. In good coat and sound on the move. 3 Revell's Haromsag Lady Tucszi

OB (4) 1 BCC & BOB Smillie-Gray's Sh Ch Oakberrow Let The Fun Be Gin JW A quality bitch of substance as the breed should be. She excelled in type, balance and coat. Correct in skull proportions, sound straight front and on very good, well padded feet. Ideal fore hand assembly, top and under line, couples, croup, hind quarters and tail set. The best on the move in this class. 2 Byrne Aldo zovolgyi - Drotos Nyuzsgo At Enryb JW. Another typical, balanced and substantial bitch with much to like about her. I preferred the angulation of winner. 3 Cooper's Deifstock Desert Rose

VB (1) 1 & BV Newman's Lanokk Violeska. A lovely lady presenting a typical outline. Correct head and expression, ideal angles fore and aft, strong level topline standing and on the move which was sound and true.
