VD (4) 1 Monkstrod Hornet (Allison) A cracking class to start with, a lovely 12 yr old, pleasing head, neck and front, Excellent body, flowing mover, beautiful white gleaming teeth! A great old boy indeed. 2 Zöldmáli U R Special (Howard) Smaller in size, also attractive head, a little straighter in shoulder than above, & tubby in body. Moving truly all ways. 3 Lanokk Szivos JW (Howard)

PD (2) 1 Redrafi Mrembo Nacho (Sweeney). CC, BOB and BP, Great puppy, his side movement so active and flowing coming from well angulated front and rear construction. A quality puppy all though, surprised at the end to find I still thought him the best in the entry, as he still has some filling out to do, but a lovely prospect, well made throughout, has the correct coat, beautiful head and eyes, well set tail, and sound all through. 2 Fitzrovia Gideons Way (Harris) Straighter in front & rear angulation, & shorter in neck, although the breed does not need or require a long neck. Lovely temperament, colour and coat coming along well, nicely handled too.

JD (1) 1 Enryb True Blue (Whitney) Comes into himself moving in profile, as he is at the gawky stage at 16 mths. Backskull a little over broad, strong foreface which is deep enough. Excellent topline and couplings. Needs time to mature of course.

PGD (7) 1 Zoldmali Olympos (Ferbrache). Neck could let into shoulders at a better angle, reasonable front & true coming towards. Pleasing firm back, moderate rear angulation. Super hard coat. Good pigment, and attractive head and expressive eyes. 2 Navarro del Fatalbecco at Cragvallie (Whiting) Needs a good groom and training to show. Nice for size and body properties. Feet very flat, moved out truly and was enjoying himself. 3 Zoldmali Monda (Sweeney)

LD (9) 1 Zoldmali Nautilus of Hazean Jun Ch Hun (Sipos & Woods) Res CC. Super boy so well muscled up and in wonderful body, this showed in his movement which was powerful and true. Grand head, neck and general forehand, deep enough in chest, excellent topline and quarters, hard coat of rich colour. A sound impressive dog. 2 Throstlenest Helios (Davidson). Similar size and proportions but not the free flowing side movement the winner had. I liked his typy head, excellent shoulders and forehand. Good bone and a lovely jacket. Correct, unexaggerated quarters.. well handled. 3 Zoldmali Lipton at Brecalde (Coxhead)

OD (6) 1st Furlums Tavaszi (Mrs Deighton) Difficult class, all moving poorly. Winner was the most together on the day. Loved his head and temperament, really good body for depth & length of ribbing. Front could be better. 2 Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal Upton) Very upright in shoulder & this reflected in his movement. Keeps a steady topline in profile. Attractive head with slightly shorter muzzle. Good underline, OK in rear, super coat. 3 Belatarr Jupiter (Spillane)

Special Working Gundog (4) 1 Ch Zoldmali Szeles Morganna JW Newman) Sturdy, maybe a bit too heavy in body, but still pretty fit. Liked his head and eyes, OK angulation front and rear, but bangs his front on the move. Moderate behind, & true there on the move. Well set and carried tail. Excellent hard, working

coat. 2 Zoltarous Lupin (Dicker) Racy & a bit too greyhoundy for me, but I had to admire his muscle tone, powerful movement, and a beautiful head.

VB (6) 1st Kisdons Attribute (Deighton) CC B VETERAN Super class all a credit to their owners. Winner has flowing side movement, moderate build all through, and not over flashy, just very correct. She looks better moving than standing, as she was a touch bored. Excellent condition of body and coat. Hope she continues to show and gain her third CC. 2 Herlinga Zaffron (Pike) Loved her too, a little over heavy in body now, but quite understandable at her age. Excellent size, lovely head and expression. Pasterns and feet a little on the weak side. 3 Herlinga Helewise (Pryer)

PB (4) 1 Lovely Luna (Sweeney) Very nice puppy, Handler needs training, she outmoved her opposition, but you have to close your eyes when she is stood up. Good type I thought. 2 Naughty Niffler (Sweeney) Taller and also an easy mover, but bangs her front coming towards. Pleasing head, good legs and tidy feet. Promising but needs time. 3 Fitzrovia Amber Nectar (Harris)

JB (4) 1 Tragus Flirty Fox (Richardson) First two very close, Just a slightly better shoulder placement on 1st swung it her way. Noble head and expression, grand front, super body and firm topline, impressive rear, Maybe lacks a little bone beneath the pasterns. 2 Morganna Anise (Newman) Solid & firm throughout, and sound moving up and down. Lovely coat and colour, excellent bone and feet, just a little straight in upper arm. Impressive youngster, and should do well in future. 3 Fradikee Just Like Fire (Pryer)

PGB (12) 1 Holsan Lenti (Bendikas) R CC Good working type and admired her strength and substance (not fat), Super head, firm body, moved well all round, maybe just a smidgen too long in loin. I liked her a lot. 2 Adel Liliana (Lewis) More compact, the breed should be slightly longer than high, she also has a free flowing gait, & is true up and down. Pasterns slope slightly too much, but a minor point on a good bitch. This was a good class to judge, and plenty of choice too! 3 Zoltarous Guelder Rose (Hammans)

LB (7) 1 Redrafi Narok (Sweeney) Sound active mover in all directions. Super bone and feet are oval, and tight. Excellent head and ear set, correct in body, strong and well proportioned.. Firm backline, and good behind.. Short of coat on the day. 2 Dolgos - Nimrod Hibernia of Nagyzabasi (Sipos & Woods) A good honest quality bitch, pleasing head and eyes which have a lovely expression. OK in body. Precise mover which was rare today. Short of coat on the day too, and needs a little more fill in of chest. 3 Deifstock Desert Rose (Cooper)

OB (2) 1 Sh Ch Kisdons Custom Made (Edminson) Good overall proportions, most lovely pigment, head and eyes. Strong neck, sound front but she does pin in coming towards. Excellent body and good behind. Great weatherproof coat of pleasing colour. Special Working Gundog (5) 1 Zoldmali Hope of Zoltarous (Dicker) 1st two both beautifully muscled and had great power from their hocks and stifles, going away. She came over as a real working gundog who could go for hours, liked her head, she was in good body and just enough coat. 2 Zoldmali Jodli (Briley) On the thin side, and looked rather ribby, but they were carried well back into a firm loin and strong back. Runs up a trifle in topline, super front and forechest, noble head and expressive eyes. In super muscle. 3 Zoltarous Guelder Rose (Hammans)

Good Citizen Dog (3) 1 Fitzrovia to be a Pilgrim (Harris) Up from limit, Good outline and balance, Carries her head at the correct angle, and nicely angulated in front. Stands on good legs and has tidy feet. 2nd

Zoltarous Guelder Rose (Hammans) Just failed in bone and feet to winner, but she has a pleasing head, sturdy body, OK in quarters angulation. Well presented and handled. 3 Maiashy Jinzu (Halstead)
