MPD 1 Sweeney's Mremba Nacho. Well grown, Stands on good bone with tight arched feet, liked his head proportions with arched neck, free mover with good angles.

PD 1 Harris' Fitzrovia Gideons Way. Shown and presented well, expression pleased with head furnishings, just needs to fill his frame, steady on the move, handles well.

JD 1 Whitney's Enryb True Blue. Pleasing in head and eye, ample substance in body for age, clean arched neck. has a good forechest, I liked his length of rib to sound rear quarters, moved out on a positive stride.

PGD (2, 1) 1 Clymer's Phantomfuror Guava. Would have preferred more substance all through, he has good head furnishings, is deep in body with spring of rib, could have been more sure of himself on the move.

LD (4) 1 Walker's Toldmall Story Of Lanokk (Imp Srb). I liked this chap in head and expression, stands up well with good bone, ample forechest, he is well bodied up and has balanced angulation which is carried through to his sound true action. 2 Thomas' Hosokter Tompa At Odinsmoke. Pleased in eye and colour blending with coat which is of correct harsh texture, good height to length ratio, ample angulation in rear quarters used to advantage on the move. 3 Sweeney's Zoldmall Monda.

OD (3) 1 Newman's Ch Toldmali Szeles Morganna JW. Good balanced proportions in head, not overdone, excellent front assembly with lay of shoulder has depth of body ample heart and lung room, carries himself well on the move giving a true action, lovely front extension with tight elbows which took him to the CC & BOB. 2 Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal. Stands over his ground to best advantage, typical headpiece, good bone, he is well bodied up with good depth, and level backline ample

width and substance in rear quarters giving a driving action. 3 Howard's Zoldmali Latin Lover. VD 1 Howard's Lanokk Szivos. 7 years, sound on handling, has forechest, carries a good length of rib, clean forehand moved with a steady, balanced gait.

MPB (3, 1) 1 Elsmere's Wilmarris Rosemary. At the moment she is at the "leggy" stage, clean arch to neck firm in back and rear quarters, good tight arched feet, she moved steady with a true front coming towards.

PB (9, 2) 1 Newman's Morganna Anis. A well deserved Res CC. A most pleasing young bitch quite mature for her age, her proportion of height to length is spot on. A most pleasing headpiece and expression, gives a very true free flowing action, excellent front extension kept her balanced and style at all times. Most promising. 2 Smillie-Gray's Oakberrow M'Lady Gin. Has substance in body with good depth, she is well ribbed up ample angulation in rear quarters, moved out with a steady action. 3 Pryer's Fradaikee Just Like Fire. JB (4, 2) 1 Morganna Anis. 2 Oakberrow M'Lady Gin.

GB (5, 2) 1 Oakberrow M'Lady Gin. 2 Court's Twelveoaks Carolina Red. Sound on handling, kept a balanced outline on the move stands on good bone, firm in back and quarters. 3 Hunt's Lanspar Kivalo.

PGB (5, 1) 1 Court's Twelveoaks Crimson Delight. CC. Very well constructed bitch, handled and shown to get the best of her. Stands on good bone with tight arched feet, has length of rib, strength in loin, liked the width of thigh, rear quarters giving the

driving action, clean neck, flows through shoulder to firm topline. She has the correct height to length as required giving the best of profiles. As sound as they come. My pleasure to award her the CC. 2

Bendikas' Holsan Lenti. I liked the kind expression on this bitch, again moves with a true and positive action, keeping her balanced outline, stands up well on good bone, has depth in body with ample rib, a sound bitch. 3 Court's Twelveoaks Carolina Red.

LB (4, 1) A class of three pleasing bitches. 1 Court's Twelveoaks Crimson Delight. 2 Sweeney's Redrafi Narok. Again this bitch carries the substance and balance as required, carried through to her ground covering action, good lines all through, handles and shows to advantage. 3 Cooper's Deifstock Desert Rose.

OB (2) 1 Smillie-Gray's Sh Ch Oakberrow Let The Fun Be Gin JW. Very sound moving bitch which won her the class, balanced angles all through, clean arched neck flowing firm level topline, ample depth in body, head and expression pleased. 2 Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Honey Bee. I liked the shape of this bitch when stacked, gave a good profile gait, kind eye, has forechest, good straight bone, sound on handling.

VB (2) 1 Pryer's Herlinga Helewise. Handles well, good depth in body with length of rib, has forechest, she had steady movement with angulation in rear quarters. 2 Court's Honey Buzzard. Was in good harsh jacket, carries a good spring of rib, steady free action, not quite as true as first.
