His oval eyes will darken with age and his pigment has depth of colour. Having a slightly arched neck of moderate length leading to strong shoulders with correct length of upper arm and good forechest with depth. He stands foursquare on well boned legs with slightly oval feet having well arched toes. Being short in loin he holds his top line well for a youngster has great moderate rear angulation he's a lively mover being true both ends, little proud of his tail but forgave as a puppy who was enjoying his outing. Coat developing well I'm confident it will be of good harsh texture already has a good beard. He is up to height although totally balanced in outline. BD & BP. JD repeat. PG, 0. LD 2, 2. O 1, 1. SBD 0. V 4, 3 1st Wearing – NLCH Zoldmali Aniz at Genlusa (imp hung) SGWG a bitch I have done well in the past and still pleases although for top honours she had to give way to youth. Still well muscled for 9 yrs carrying correct body weight. Love her medium size of balanced shape with no exaggeration she still has correct dentition with a darker shade eye as expected for her age giving kind expression & desired facial furnishing she is clean in neck with good muscle tone over well laid shoulders. OK for bone on tight feet. She has correct coat texture covering all of body and legs, animated mover BV. GC 0. SB 1, 1. PB 1, 1. JB 2, 0 1st Wearing- Vernum Ventulus Hanga at Genlusa Imp Naf Taf. At correct stage for her 12 months very balanced head qualities her facial furnishings are developing although body and legs will take time but what is there is extremely harsh. She has a perfect level back held strong on the move with best sloping croup rounded to set of tail which is carried horizontally, great hindquarters being well muscled & moderately angled being true both standing and moving which was strong and easy. Both girls need further development in chest but they have time. RBB & BJ. 2nd Pryer – Fradikee Just Like Fire, this girl had the 1 1/2 inch length of coat of all the exhibits today with good undercoat. A different head to 1st being slightly flatter in skull, correct oval medium sized eye with colour and pigment OK for 15 months of age. Being clean in neck although just a tad stuffy. She has decent bone with required long forearm. I preferred elbows of 1st. she has a level top line and moderately angulated rear on excellent oval shaped tight feet she moved out well unaffected by the heat. PG 2, 1. 1st Richardson Tragus Flirty fox what a beautiful headed feminine young lady with the kindest expression from her oval eyes of matching coat colour her outline flows with good muscle coverage has depth of chest with good underline & adequate bone for her medium size, she's strong in top line especially on the move which is where she excels eating the ground with ease at one with her handler. She has moderate spring of rib of good length and a short loin leads into slight slope to croup, her tail set is perfect having horizontal carriage with a harsh jacket to complete a very pleasing picture BB & BOB.
