

VD (2,1) 1 Spillane & Spillane Sh Ch Belatarr Hercules Smart and typy 9 year old male who presents a balanced outline. Masculine in head with an intelligent expression. Good reach of neck leading to a well made front assembly. Level topline, ribs sprung and well back to a firm loin, slight slope to croup and well set tail. Developed quarters which he used well on the move. Harsh jacket and desired furnishings. Moved covering the ground well but unfortunately was unsound in the challenge.

PD (1) 1 Gray's Zoldmali Bolero IMP(SRB) 8 months and showing good substance throughout. Pleasing head of good proportions, eyes still needing to darken, which should come with age. Good body proportions, just needs to strengthen in topline as he matures. Well developed quarters which were used well in profile. Coat still needing to come but what he had was harsh.

PGD (1) 1 Collier's Belatarr America. Masculine head with a lively expression which showed in his super temperament. Squarely built firm in topline, tail set on low and used well on the move. Developed quarters. Moves a little wide behind. Super coat and condition with desired furnishings.

LD (3) 1 Whitney's Enryb True Blue Very smart young dog presenting a typical outline and full of quality. He is still young and needs to fill his frame, which he will do as he matures. Masculine head of correct proportions. Strong neck and a good front assembly. Body as you would desire at this age, just needs to fill in a little in front. Level topline and slight slope to the croup. Quarters well developed and used to advantage on the move. Positive ground covering action. Good harsh jacket and required furnishings. 2 Sauro's Furlums Heath. Good type, make and shape. Very appealing head and expression. Strong neck, a little upright in shoulder. Good depth to forechest, ribs well back. Lost his topline a little on the move, good finish to the croup. Balanced angles fore and aft and has a good coat of harsh texture and undercoat. 3 Thomas's Hosokter Tompa at Odinsmoke.

OD (3) 1 Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal. A dog I have judged before and lovely to see him her as a fully mature example of the breed. He has a very appealing head and expression, he almost talks to you with his eyes. Head is well proportioned and has desired furnishings. Good reach of neck which led to a very good front assembly. Depth to his forechest and well ribbed back to a firm loin. Good proportions and is slightly longer than tall. Good topline and tailset. Quarters developed and required angulation. Super condition and you could see him doing a days work. Very accurate footfall on the move and is true out and back. Covers the ground with ease and has good carriage. Pleased to award him DCC and in the BOB challenge he got a little giddy so had to pass the baton to his kennel mate today. 2 Byrne's Ch Enryb Simply Red. Another top draw example of the breed. Presenting type and balance. Masculine head and expression. Strong neck and well placed shoulders, depth to forechest and straight front. Level topline which never faltered. Superb muscular condition. Quarters well made and used to advantage on the move. Super coat and condition. On the move he covered the ground in a effortless manner, just not quite a tidy in front action as Fox Appeal. Very happy to award him the RCC. 3 Spillane & Spillane, Belatarr Jupiter.

MPB (2) 1 Byrne's Aldoovolgyi - Drotos Csermely At Enryb (Imp Hun). WOW this young lady is a little cracker. Beautiful outline balanced and typy. Feminine throughout with the right amount of substance, she just flows from nose to tail. Beautifully put together with superb skeletal structure. Attending her first show and took everything in her stride, just needing a little flare to complete the picture, which will come. Super coat and condition, she moved so well and collected for a youngster. No hesitation in awarding her the RCC and BP. 2 Busby's Starshot Hawkeye. Very raw at this stage and a little all over the place on the move, however she had a ball and enjoyed every moment, which is what matters at this age. Good substance, pleasing head and expression. Level topline balanced angles both ends and good legs and feet. Super coat at this age. She just needs a little time and practice.

PB (2) 1 Byrne's Aldozovolyi - Drotos Csermely At Enryb (Imp HUN) 2 Aldridge's Nagyzabasi Orlagh for Gwaithmaes. Slightly finer all through at this stage. Feminine head and expression, foreface needs to develop as she matures. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Good body proportions and correct finish to the croup. Balanced angles both ends. Coat coming in well. Covered the ground well on the move. JB (1) 1 Smillie-Gray's Oakberrow M'Lady Gin. Bigger built bitch but still maintaining femininity. Well proportioned head and feminine expression. Good reach of neck and well placed shoulders. Depth to forechest and ribs beginning to spring. Decent topline and good finish to the croups. Moved out well with a positive action. Out of coat at the moment but I could feel the texture was there.

YB (3,1) 1 Richardson's Tragus Flirty Fox Liked the size and balance of this lady. Lovely head and expression, good front assembly and depth to her forechest. Well ribbed back and firm in loin. Croup falls a little. Well made quarters and stands on good legs and feet. Super coat and condition. She covered the ground with ease but was being moved to fast at times and she lost a little co-ordination in footfall. 2 Smillie-Gray's Oakberrow M'Lady Gin.

PGB (1 ) 1 Lewis' Adel Liliana. Liked the type of this bitch, feminine throughout with enough substance. Lovel well proportioned head with an intelligent expression. Strong and clean in neck which fitted neatly into her shoulders. Good topline and finish to the croup. Ribs well back and firm in loin. Quarters developed and moderated angulation fore and aft. Good coat which was harsh. She moved out very well and was paced beautifully by her handler to get the best from her. Super rapport between them and it was all about the dog.

LB (2,1) 1 Elders' Enryb Skye Blue Very good type of bitch. Well made throughout and balanced, just a little too much of her for my taste. Lovely head and expression with a hint of mischief in her eye. Good reach of neck and super shoulder placement. Depth to her forechest and well ribbed back to a firm and powerful loin. Developed quarters and required bend to her stifles. Harsh jacket and in firm order throughout. On the move she has a very accurate footfall and covered the ground well.

OB (4,1) 1Upton's Sh Ch Tragus Honey Bee. Lovely bitch from any angle, she had what I was looking for in type, balance, size and construction. Feminine head which is of the correct proportions, well moulded and a super expression. Clean and strong in neck and this fitted neatly into a well made front assembly. Good depth to her forechest, well ribbed back and firm in loin. Gentle slope to the croup and well set on tail. The thing that struck me when going over her is that your hands just flow and everything fits together. On the move she had an accurate footfall and moved with carriage and covered the ground with ease. All topped off with a super coat and condition. My pleasure to award her the CC and BOB. 2 Smillie-Gray's Sh Ch Oakberrow Let The Fun Be Gin JW Bigger framed bitch and carrying a little weight today. Feminine head with a very appealing expression. Good reach of Neck and well placed shoulders. Topline not as firm as it could be. Well ribbed back and correctly proportioned loin. Good bend to her stifles and stands on neat feet. Coat on the change and a little soft here today. On the move she had an effortless side gait and covered the ground well. 3 Aldridge's Gwaithmaes Aoife
