OD (2 0) 1 Sauro Fowlums Heath A substantial 3-year old boy with one of the best coats of the day, from his beautifully-furnished head through to his harsh wire jacket. He has an elegant and very masculine head with good stop and blunt muzzle and scores, in particular, with his very substantial depth and length of rib, coupled with good topline and correct croup/tail-set. His angulation is balanced and matching front to rear although would like him less upright in the shoulder and straight of stifle as well as a touch longer in body. Good feet and he tracked well when on the move, holding his topline level. **BD.** 2 Guest Sh Ch Bardantop Banoffee A 4-year old boy of ideal size, presented in excellent, hard condition with a tight, harsh russet wire jacket with full-body coverage. Another with a masculine and well-proportioned head, with good, dark eye and a muscular neck. Pleasing length and spring of rib, not overdone, and a nice tuck-up into a strong loin. He stood on possibly the best feet of the day, super-tightly knit and well arched. He is well balanced front to back, allowing him to move with an efficient gait, but, as with 1, I would like more angulation both of stifle and shoulder to upper arm. **RBD**

PB (1 0) 1 Byrne Enryb Tickled Pink 6 and ½ month old girl at her first show but she was the best constructed exhibit present today and a picture of balance when stacked. An appealing, feminine head with furnishings coming in perfectly and good eye pigmentation for age; already showing lovely depth and length of rib, she has good upper arm and super lay of shoulder with a very prominent pro-sternum - a rarity in the breed these days; good neck flowing into level top-line, excellent width of 2nd thigh and optimal, moderate but well-defined rear angulation. Her movement was slightly erratic, as might be expected at her debut, and was wide at the elbow & her coat should be spot-on in a few more months. Considered for **RBB** but just a little too raw as she was finding her feet today, but surely a star of the near future.

JB (1 0) 1 Aldridge Nagyzabasi Orlagh for Gwaithmaes A distinctly feminine girl of just over 12 months with much to like about her. Moderate throughout but perfectly balanced and this allowed her to be the best moving exhibit today with an effortless, elegant profile action showing good reach and drive, a low, daisy-cutter action and perfectly held top-line, which was a delight to see. Coming and going she was a little close at the rear (possibly moved too fast?) Would like a broader muzzle; her facial furnishings are still developing, as befits her age, so these will soften her head in time, however, she already has an absolutely superb, harsh russet jacket, is moderately angulated front & rear with correct croup and tail-set. Very good length of rib, and nice tuck-up creating an overall athletic but graceful picture. I would like just a touch more depth of rib, but this too should develop with maturity. Super, tight feet and good pasterns.

PGB (4 2) Two totally different types, but both with their merits and illustrating how much variance there still is in the breed. 1 Revell Haromsag Lady Tucszi An extremely robust 3-year old girl; deep red in colour, her coat is still developing. Really excellent length of upper arm and shoulder placement; good bend of stifle, not over-done and well matched to her front angles. Outstanding depth, length and spring of rib give her terrific substance without being overdone or coarse. Good height to length ratio and solid top-line although her tail-set is too high. Her movement was inconsistent today, which cost her against such strong competition when in the subsequent **OB** class. 2 Lewis Adel Liliana Also 3 years of age but a much finer girl throughout, with a pretty, well furnished and correctly proportioned head and excellent body coat. Moderately angulated, but balanced front to rear she moved better than 1, with a good action coming and going. She has super depth of rib, sitting well against her elbow, but I would like a little more length of rib; her croup is a

touch steep and she lost her top-line on occasion. Nice tight feet and correct, slightly sloping pasterns.

OB (5 0) A good class of quality bitches which made for a difficult decision. 1 Byrne Aldoovolgyi-Drotos Csermely at Enryb (Imp Hun) Only 13 Months of age but already looking fully finished, this is an impressive example of the breed. She has a dense and harsh wire coat with excellent facial furnishings and well-proportioned head. Topline, croup and tail-set are all pleasing and she has terrific strength in her upper thigh with super rear angulation – not over-done but with the perfect bend of stifle. Good, tight feet and correct pasterns; her upper arm to shoulder angle is sufficient, though not as good as 2, but she has a super chest with nice tuck-up and good musculature throughout. She moved wide behind when setting off but proved that she could straighten-up her tracking as she went and, ultimately won the class because of her more accurate movement overall. In a tight class was pleased to award her BB and then BOB. 2 Smillie-Gray Sh Ch Oakberrow Let The Fun Be Gin JW Another lovely example of the breed who I had the pleasure of judging as a youngster. She is now 4 years of age and with her title. Always joyful, she has the most beautiful head with a really melting expression, excellent furnishings and a good dark eye. When stacked she presents a near-perfect picture – a touch longer in body than 1, she has correct pasterns & excellent front angulation with well-laid shoulders into a level top line, gently sloping croup and correct tail set. Rear angulation is equally good and is balanced with her front. Her chest is also outstanding, with depth to below her elbows and a very good length of rib into a moderate tuck-up. Her feet could be a touch tighter and on the move she was close in front and not as tidy as 1 overall, which cost her the win today, but her many strengths still secured her RBB. 3 Newman Lanokk Violeska
