VD 2(0) 1. Howard's Lanokk Szivos JW. Well built on strong lines, deep in chest, elbow could be tighter, skull broad giving head square appearance, in good jacket, moved true out and back, proud of his tail. 2. Heslop's Lyharr Flavio Akos for Bonisla. Finer in build, top-line not level, not happy here today, close behind on the move.

PD 3(0) 1. Wearing's Zoldmali Dura at Genlusa NAF TAF. Well constructed medium sized head, pleasing with good furnishings, moderate neck, straight forelegs, body of good length, moved in profile with drive. 2. Tasker's Zoldmali Ezmi NAF. Happy chap enjoying his day, balanced on the stand, coat needs time to develop, pleasing head and eye, moderate rear angulation, moved out well. 3. Harris' Fitzrovia Take A Chance.

JD 1(0) 1. Harris' Fitzrovia Gideons Way. Smart young chap topped with the best of heads, correct furnishings, muscled moderate neck with no dewlap, tight fitting elbows, level back with good tail set, coat of correct texture, moderate rear angles which showed in his driving movement with good foot fall, RDCC.

LD 2(0) 1. Thomas' Hosokter Tompa at Odinsmoke. Won here for type, pleasing head with moderate stop, straight muzzle and broad nose, coat of good feel, developed deep chest, elbows could be tighter fitting, good sweep of stifle, moved out well and on the round. 2. Howard's Zoldmali Latin Lover. Darker in coat, head in profile of good shape, found him to have untypical eye and expression which spoilt the overall appearance, strong neck into well laid shoulders, good depth of chest to tight fitting elbows, shown in good jacket, moved out with drive.

OD 3(0) 1. Deighton's Furlums Tavaszi. This chap filled my eye with his distinguished appearance, robust in build, built on strong frame, balanced fore and aft on the stack, best of heads with intelligent expression, well muscled clean neck free from dewlap, straight forelegs, good feet, level back held on move, covered ground well with reach and drive, DCC & BOB. 2. Byrne's Ch. Enryb Simply Red. Different type entirely, heavier in frame and bone, head pleasing with good furnishings, deep chest to withers, strong arched neck into level top-line, deep chest, coat of softer feel, moved out well with purpose. 3. Moss' Sh Ch. Ewtor Nobody Does It Better.

VB 3(0) 1. Deighton's Kisdons Attribute. Nice class of mature ladies, best of heads topped this bitch, super eye and expression, balanced throughout, lovely lay back of shoulder, level back, good tail set, coat of good texture, moved out free with reach and drive. 2. Guest's Bardantop Plum Duff. Many of the same attributes apply to this bitch, also other top drawer head, wearing a thicker jacket today, lovely on the move, these girls can show the young stock how to do it! 3. Wearing's NL Ch. Zoldmali Anizs at Genlusa SGWC.

PB 2(0) 1. Cooper's Hazean Donetsk to Deifstock (IKC). Sweet feminine pup, pleasing shape to head and muzzle, sufficient furnishings, eye needs to darken, balanced on the stand with good length of body, not settled on the move today but saw enough. 2. Heslop's Bonisla The Inner Light. Not happy here today, body longer cast, head needs time, top-line has a tendency to rise over croup, erratic on the move.

JB 1(0) 1. Wearing's Venum Ventulus Hanga at Genlusa (imp HUN). Feminine bitch, pleasing head, would prefer different eye shape, body proportions balanced, slight arch to neck, level top-line, movement erratic. PGB 3(0) 1. Newton's Jaktays Vida. Pleasing bitch of good size, neat feminine pretty head, no coarseness, balanced fore and aft, coat of good feel, moved freely driving from rear, RBCC. 2. Edminson's Kisdon Goldhill. Taller bitch built on strong lines, balanced outline, pleasing head with dark eye, strong neck, coat of harsh texture, straight well boned front legs, moved well. 3. Hunt's Lanspar Kivalo.

LB 4(1) 1. Newman's Morganna Anise. Honest true to type bitch of medium size, lovely quality head, well placed ear, neck devoid of dewlap, well laid shoulders, level back, good tail set, well developed thighs which showed on the move, she had a free moving action driving from the rear with correct foot fall, BCC. 2. Moss' Enryb Scarlett O'Hara at Ewtor. Good head topped this bitch, eye and expression good, good furnishings, deep chest to elbow, coat softer to the touch, bit slack in movement out and back, nor surprising as I believe she had just returned from maternal duties. 3. Forster's Belatarr Venus.

OB 5(1) 1. Elders' Enryb Skye Blue. Well up on size bitch, built on a strong frame, typical head, eye and expression, strong neck into well laid shoulders, level back sloping slightly at croup, well developed thighs with moderate angulation, on the move she had reach and drive. 2. Byrne's Aldoovolgyi-Drotos Nyuzsgo at Enryb JW. Smaller than 1, skull moderately broad and well proportioned, furnishings on head completed the look, elbows could be tighter, moderate sweep of stifle, hocks well let down, covered ground well on the move. 3. Cooper's Deifstock Desert Rose.
