1st: 4476 COLLIER, Ms I E Belatarr America

Very smart 2yr old dog of excellent breed type and coat texture. Very typical, well-furnished head with an excellent eye and expression, Well-made front which he stands over nicely. Good depth and length to rib and standing slightly longer than he is tall. Firm, level back but does fall a little steep in croup. Moderately angled behind and shown in superb muscle condition. Moving he could've been a fraction cleaner coming towards, but very impressive in profile. A lovely dog.

Class 1665 LD (4 Entries) Abs: 2

1st: 4504 WEST, Mrs A Junetta Dorjan

Mature dog of decent type. A well-made boy with an excellent harsh coat. Decent head being slightly rounded with a moderately broad skull and moderate stop, but would've liked a softer expression. Strong well-muscled neck but would've liked him slightly better in shoulder. Good length to rib, strong loin and decent tail set. Won the class on movement.

2nd: 4501 SUMMERFIELD, Mrs R D Miadsc Cast a Spell

Preferred this boy for type, but couldn't match the winner for conformation, movement and maturity. Correct head proportions with kind eye and good furnishings. Coat of excellent colour and texture. Moderately angled all through but tended to stand a little narrow in front on the day. Moved ok, didn't quite have the open side gait of the winner.

Class 1666 OD (3 Entries) Abs: 1 – Two outstanding dogs

1st: 4474 BYRNE, Mrs Jean Ch ENRYB SIMPLY RED

First time I had seen this dog in the flesh and what a cracking example of the breed he is. I loved everything about him. He has the most wonderful head and expression, masculine without being course, just the right amount of furnishing and the most lively and intelligent of expressions. His neck is well muscled and leads to a superior forehead and the best forechest and upper arm in the entry. Strong, well-proportioned body, level back and excellent tail set; Hindquarters were beautifully muscled and moderate in their angulation. On the move he was totally co-ordinated and effortless; straight up and back and impressive in profile. Put down in outstanding coat and condition, he could not be denied the CC and later BOB over his very beautiful kennel mate. His breeder/owner must be very proud. Congratulations!

2nd: 4503 UPTON, Mr P & Mrs L & Mr G Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal

There's no denying that this beautiful dog has been a terrific ambassador for the breed. I have judged him many times and I could not have sung his praises any louder. He is full of breed type, owns the most wonderful head and expression and is so beautifully put together. I still rate him very highly; however, on the day, he had to give way to the younger competitor in his prime. A very well deserved RCC.

Another old favourite of mine that I was delighted to see on the day. I last judged him in 2017 and thought highly of him then. Larger than I normally go for, but for me he presents such a typy picture. Beautifully headed with the correct amount of furnishings, eyes of medium size and slightly oval in shape with a kind, intelligent expression. Moderate length of neck, well placed shoulders and super return of upper arm, correct top line, underline and croup. On the move he is still very sound and coordinated. I enjoyed seeing him again, thank you for bringing him. BVIB.

1st: 4475 BYRNE, Mrs Jean Aldozovolgyi - Drotos Csermely at Enryb NAF

What a beautiful puppy this is. She is everything you would want for her age and more. She is balanced, typy, and so very well constructed. She owns a glorious, well-furnished head with fine, well placed ears that frame it beautifully. Her neck is muscled, of moderate length and sits on excellent shoulders that flow seamlessly into her top line and superb tail set. She has excellent fore chest, good length and depth to ribs already and an excellent underline with no hint of tuck up. She has excellent hindquarters and is well let down in hock. She was presented to me in hard muscular condition and faultless presentation. On the move she excelled, she was clean coming and going and excellent in profile. In the challenge I couldn't take my eyes off her and despite her tender age, awarded her the BCC. She is as good as I have seen in the breed; what an exciting career she has ahead of her!

2nd: 4470 ALDRIDGE, Ms Y L Lesley Nagyzabasi Orlagh for Gwaithmaes

A finer girl than one and giving a lot away in maturity. Feminine in head with a correct eye and fine, neatly folder ears. Moderate in her angulation, enough depth, firm top line but falls off a little steep in croup for ideal. Excelled in coat texture and was very impressive on the go around.

Class 1670 JB (3 Entries) Abs: 0

1st: 4491 NEWMAN, Mrs Rachel MORGANNA ANISE

Another absolute cracker and one I had admired in the ring previously. She excels in all departments. She has type in abundance. Feminine in head with a super eye and expression. Neat fine ears, clean throat and a well-furnished muzzle and brow. Her neck flows beautifully into her shoulders, she has ample length and depth of rib, excellent bone and feet, excellent underline and moderately turned stifles. Presented in the most wonderful condition with a crisp, immaculate jacket. On the move she was a pleasure to watch. Showy and full of herself. I struggled to separate her and the PB winner, but in the end, I went for the slightly softer finish to croup of the CC winner. I can't imagine she'll be waiting long for her title. RCC.

2nd: 4496 SMILLIE-GRAY, Mrs Doreen Oakberrow M'Lady Gin

Bigger framed girl of lovely type but still maintains her femininity, she has excellent strength throughout and presents the required robust appearance. Excellent head and expression. Ample reach of neck set into well placed shoulders. Good depth of chest with plenty of heart room, firm topline and very good tailset. A very sound mover both coming and going but was a little overweight on the day. Like her very much.

3rd: 4478 CONNOLLY, Mrs S M Bardantop Witchway Benmorbry

1st: 4492 RICHARDSON, Mr S Tragus Flirty Fox

Well this very typy girl didn't give her handler an easy ride today! She owns a beautiful head with a delightful amount of furnishings and certainly has a wicked glint in her eye. An excellent size to this girl and carries a super textured and coloured coat that is very well presented. She's very balanced all through but it's when she moves that she comes alive. She is so very sound and has such a lovely attitude and carriage. In the challenge, she just never seemed to settle into her stack and relax enough to take higher honours on the day. I wish her all the best for will be a well-deserved title.

2nd: 4489 MOSS, Mr A D ewtor guilty as sinn

2 ½ yr old that was very typy and typical of the breed, she has a lovely, well-furnished head with kind eye and excellent length and depth muzzle. She has a good front, well laid shoulders and a very good return of upper arm. She's well boned and robust. Ribs are well sprung and carried well back to a firm loin and moderate hindquarters. She was a little untidy behind on the move today which cost her the class. Nevertheless, a lovely girl that also has a title ahead of her I'm sure.

1st: 4481 COURT, Mr R Twelveoaks Crimson Delight

Another very good bitch, so well made all through with excellent furnishings and coat. Good front, excellent topline, good length and depth to ribs if perhaps a little long in loin. Moderate in hindquarters and used the well on the move. Was just a fraction wide coming towards.

2nd: 4479 COOPER, Mr & Mrs S Deifstock Desert Rose

Honest bitch of good type with a decent head and expression. Excellent front angulation and lay of shoulder, enough bone, good length and depth of rib, fraction long in loin and top line could be firmer on the stack. Nicely angulated behind. Decent mover, but a little narrow coming on on the day.

3rd: 4485 HOLT, Mrs Pauline & HOLT, Mr Philip Maiashy Akori

Class 1673 OB (5 Entries) Abs: 2

Two very worthy champions headed this class.

1st: 4502 UPTON, Mr P & Mrs L Sh Ch Tragus Honey Bee

There's no denying the quality of this bitch, she excels for type and size. Excellent head and expression: harsh, crisp coat of excellent colour and very well presented. Good front and well placed shoulders, enough length of rib and no sign of tuck up in loin. On the day I just felt she lacked the overall sparkle of the younger competition to take the top awards.

2nd: 4495 SMILLIE-GRAY, Mrs Doreen Sh Ch Oakberrow Let The Fun Be Gin JW

Lots to like about this beautifully made mature bitch, Longer cast than the winner and a touch softer in coat, but so well put together with excellent angulation front and back. Precise on the move and very sound. Just carrying a fraction too much weight on the day.
