Many of the males seemed very proud of their tails, which spoilt their outlines on the move, also some of the coat presentations were rather untidy, especially where they were stripped right down.

Class of very promising youngsters.

1st STEPHENS's Farnfield Pickpocket for Brightmeadow BPD & BP

Raw baby, built on good lines, with plenty of scope, presented in good coat, well proportioned head, with good furnishings, super expression & dark eye, balanced body throughout, well developed chest, plenty of bone moved with excellent stride and good co ordination, on strong feet, which need to tighten, needs a large ring, super ring presence.

2nd MORTON & CAMERON's EWTOR FLY ME TO THE MOON

Pleasing youngster not quite the balance of first, but everything there to mature into, head of good shape, coat coming through nicely, well developed thighs for age, strong tidy feet, moved out well, close and rather loose behind, to be expected at this age.

3rd DAVIDSON's Farnfield Huntsmen.

1st SPILLANE's Belatarr Kodiak.

Best mover in this class, not quite the balanced masculine head of 2nd as yet, but has a lovely expression, tidy front, lovely feet & good rear angulation, strong through neck, good lay of shoulders, excellent body proportioned, well ribbed back, thighs well developed, moved with plenty of drive.

2nd WEARING's Zoldmali Daru at Genlusa ( Imp Serb) NAF TAF

Good balance to this medium sized youngster, not so mature as first in body proportions, well furnished pleasing head shape, tidy front, tight feet, good length to body, moved out well, but not the positive action of 1st.

3rd MORTON & CAMERON's EWTOR FLY ME TO THE MOON

Res DAVIDSON's Farnfield Huntsmen.

JD (3 Entries) Abs: 0

1st BEARDSHALL's Karndor Tamas.

Good overall type, correct well proportioned head & good eye colour, tidy well boned front & firm feet, good texture to coat, ample rear angulation, moved with drive, could be a bit more positive, rather proud of his tail, which distracted from his outline, should mature on well.

2nd GRAY's Zoldmali Bolero IMP(SRB)

Different type to 1st, & not the expression, eye could be a little darker, needs to strengthen through topline, good bone & firm feet, muscular neck well developed chest, good quarters, harsh coat, could do with a little more to finish, moved true, a little close behind.

1st HARRIS's Tullis Scott Fitzrovia Gideons Way.

Well made with good balance, liked his well proportioned head & expressive dark eye, strong bone & tidy feet, level through back, wide well developed thighs, good dark jacket & furnishings, excellent ground covering action on a good stride, tail carried a little high.

1st LUMASIA's Redrafi Mrembo Nacho - RCC

Easy winner here, super clean outline & excellent balance, well proportioned head, expressive dark eye, strong well boned forelegs & tight feet, muscular neck & clean shoulders, elbows close to body, well sprung ribs & carried well back, strong loin, super muscular thighs, sound at both ends, moving on a good stride, presented in good coat.

2nd SUMMERFIELD's Miadsc Cast a Spell.

Not the clean outline of 1st & couldn't match his movement, balanced head, dark eye, would like a little more length of neck, strength through loin, plenty of bone, firm feet, ample width to thighs, moved o.k tail carried a little high.

3rd HOWARD's Zoldmali Latin Lover.

1st UPTON's Sh Ch Tragus Fox Appeal - CC & BOB.

So pleased to have the opportunity to go over this lovely exhibit. Well made throughout with excellent balance, slightly longer than tall, presented in rock hard condition, and the best of harsh coats, could certainly do a days work. Masculine head with the softest expression & well furnished, tidy well boned forelegs, firm feet, clean neck, well sprung ribs, strong through topline & muscular loin, wide thighs with excellent rear angulation, super sound driving action with excellent tail carriage, at one with his handler.

2nd GUEST's Sh Ch Bardantop Banoffee.

Typical throughout, presented in hard condition, with excellent substance, and of good size, harsh texture to coat, well proportioned head with dark eye, straight forelegs, strength through body & loin, super muscled quarters, sound front movement a little close in hind action, not the coordinated movement of 1st or my Res CC today.

Well made, with super balance, & harsh jacket, presents a clean outline when stacked, plenty of work in her head, softest expression, well boned forelegs, standing on tight feet, good lay of shoulders, nice wide thighs, sound action, fore & after, not much to choose between first two, just thought first had the edge on movement.

2nd COOPER's Hazean Donetsk to Deifstock (IKC)

Quality youngster, with everything in the correct place, plenty of bone & substance, super balanced feminine head,

with dark eye, the best of fronts, clean through neck, well placed shoulders, deep chest, muscular well developed hindquarters, presented in a rich harsh coat, moved out soundly at both ends.

I have judged this bitch before, as a puppy, and did her well, and today I hadn't changed my opinion, presents a super outline, still needs to fill out her frame a little to finish, well proportioned head with the softest expression plenty of furnishings, strong wire coat, tidy front, level back, so sound moving, on an excellent ground covering stride, holding herself well super in profile, with good tail carriage.

2nd HUNT's Lanspar Kivalo

Well made bitch, in a smaller frame, with excellent head proportions & expression, tidy front, ample bone to forelegs, strength through body, not the hindquarters of first, level topline, held on the move, sound action.

3rd LUMASIA's Redrafi Kalema.

VHC LINSELL-CLARK's TWELVEOAKS DANDEE RED.

LB (5 Entries) Abs: 2

Rather mixed class.

1st NEWTON's Jaktays Vida.

Classic outline, with excellent balance throughout, correct wire, russet coloured coat feminine head with dark eye & soft expression, strong neck, well laid shoulders, deep chest, strong through loin, good width to second thigh, moved soundly with good reach, just preferred the longer ground covering stride of CC & RCC.

2nd LUMASIA's Redrafi Ol Tukai.

Not the outline of first, or the shoulder placement, liked her head proportions & expression, tidy front & feet, well sprung ribs, moved soundly holding her topline, not the reach of winner.

3rd SMILLIE-GRAY's Oakberrow M'Lady Gin.

OB(6 Entries) Abs: 2

1st UPTON's Sh Ch Tragus Honey Bee.

Super bitch from all angles, so well balanced, for size & substance, with excellent wire coat & furnishings throughout, feminine head with the softest expression, clean through neck & well placed shoulders, tidy front assembly, level topline, good ribs & strong loin, firm muscletone to thighs & strong hocks, moved with excellent drive, just felt the dog held himself better for BOB.

2nd CONNOLLY's Bardantop Rumbaba With Benmorbry.

Well proportioned honest bitch, presented in hard condition, balanced head with soft expression & dark eye, plenty of wire to coat of rich russet colour, tidy front with well boned forelegs, liked her clean shoulder placement, firm muscletone to well angled thighs moved out soundly on firm feet, a little close behind, looks like she could work all day.

1st BEARDSHALL's Zoldmali Kefir Of Lanokk JW Sh.CM.  
Well balanced relatively young veteran of almost 7 1/2 yrs, presents clean outline when stacked, lost a little on the move, good eye & balance to her head, plenty of bone & tidy firm feet, well placed shoulders, good depth of chest, muscular thighs, harsh wire coat, moved ok not quite the drive I would have liked.

2nd SUMMERFIELD's Ambermoore Tanzanite Blue At Miadsc.

Another lovely veteran, with good breed type, shown in firm condition, & harsh jacket, not so clean in outline as 1st, feminine head, firm muscular neck, level through topline, good width to thighs, moved out well, not so tidy in front as first.

3rd GUEST's Bardantop Plum Duff.

Pleasing type, with decent balance, not the expression of 1st, well boned with good feet, firm quarters, sound moving, would prefer more driving action.
