

Critique Hungarian Wirehaired Vizsla, Southern Counties 2024

Puppy Dog (3)

1. Ewtor Barking at The Moon

A very handsome puppy, well balanced and well proportioned. Beautiful head with excellent skull. Well set ears. Excellent expression. Strong neck, well set. Well angulated in front. Excellent topline. Plenty of angulation behind, more than needed. Excellent coat structure. At his best he moved well from the side, keeping his outline and balance, still somewhat loose in his elbows. An excellent prospect and one for the near future. **Best Puppy, Best Male and BOS**

2. Zoltarous Wasabi for Dhlascar

A dog puppy that has not come as far in his development as the winner. Very pleasing skull, would prefer darker eyes. Reasonable neck. Good forechest for his age, stood well over his front legs. Firm topline, just long enough in his body. Needs to develop in coat and quite proud of his tail. A pleasing mover when he got into his stride.

3. Zenzoes Romeo with Oakberrow

Junior Dog (2)

1. Belatarr Kodiak

Strong, masculine dog, instantly attractive. Lovely character. Strong, masculine, well proportioned head with excellent expression. Very good ears. Strong neck. Balanced angulation both ends. Firm topline, well set tail. Fully developed in body. Excellent coat. Kept his outline and balance on the move, if rather bowlegged behind. **Reserve Best Male**

2. Zoldmali Daru at Genlusa

Another well proportioned male with quality. Typical head, if not the expression of the winner. Rather large ears. Pleasing neck and topline. Would prefer less fall-away over the croup, still opened up quite well in movement from the side. Coat not at its best in condition, but with quite pleasing structure.

Post Graduate Dog (2,2)

Open Dog (1)

1. Belatarr Jupiter

A big, masculine dog, I would absolutely not want any more of him. Lovely temperament. Masculine head, I would not want him any longer in muzzle. Pleasing ears. Strong neck. Ample forechest and excellent return of upper arm, deep chest. Firm topline. Well angulated behind. Moved with a very pleasing balance from the side with medium drive, firm as seen from the front, if bowlegged behind. Excellent coat. Well presented.

1. Zoltarous Wasabi for Dhalascar

Veteran Dog and Bitch (1)

1. NI.Ch. Zoldmali Anizs at Genlusa

Ten year old, very elegant and feminine bitch. Somewhat reminiscent of a short-haired Vizsla both for body proportions and for her coat quality. Lovely, typical head. Attractive expression. Pleasing neck, well set. Tends to hunch up a bit in her topline. Very moderately angulated behind. Active and happy mover, striding out reasonably well in both ends. Enjoying her day in the ring.

Good Citizen Dog&Bitch (1)

1. Hazean Donetsk to Deifstock

Very attractive bitch, well proportioned and of excellent type, size and overall appearance, she filled my eye. Feminine head with quality, I would not want a longer muzzle. Excellent neck, shoulder and front, neck smoothly flowing into a firm topline. Tends to fall of a bit too much over her croup. Balanced angulation behind. Excellent coat, both on body and limbs. Very well presented. She moved well from the side, keeping her balance and outline, firm in front, but needs to improve as seen from behind. ***Best bitch and BOB***

Special Beginners Bitch (1,1)

Puppy Bitch (4,1)

1. Etna Garamparty for Starshot

Very feminine bitch, rather short-coated on the day and appearing rather square in her body proportions. Typical, feminine head. Needs to develop in chest and get her elbows more under her body. Firm topline. Her best feature is her light and effortless movement. Very much in between coats.

2. Ewtor Wishing On A Star

A bitch with better body proportions, and I preferred her for type. Typical head and pleasing ears. Excellent neck and topline. She needs no more angulation behind. Excellent coat. Not showing enough confidence today and her shyness was unfortunately quite evident in her movement as well.

Junior Bitch (3,1)

1. Hazean Donets to Deifstock

2. Enryb Lily The Pink

A strong, powerful bitch, only just feminine enough overall, and the same thing goes for her head. Pleasing ears. Moderate neck. Adequately angulated in front. Deep and capacious chest. I would have preferred a straighter topline. Well angulated behind. Excellent coat. Well handled. Moved well from the side if rather narrow behind.

Post Graduate Bitch (2)

1. Venum Ventulus Hanga at Genlusa

Feminine bitch of pleasing size and shape. Typical head with a somewhat strong skull, correct length of muzzle. Pleasing ears. Strong neck with a pleasing nape. Moderate angulation both ends. Firm topline, little tuck-up. Appeared rather smooth-coated from a distance, but on close inspection she has pleasing structure to the wire-hair she has. A positive, active mover from all angles.

2. Starshot Hawkeye

A very richly coated bitch. Within size, but rather short on her legs. Pleasing skull, I would not want a longer muzzle. Strong neck. Well angulated both ends. Firm topline. Today sown in a very long coat. Moved OK from the side, but could be sounder behind.

Open Bitch (2)

1. Deifstock Desert Rose

A strong bitch, just feminine enough and I would not want any more of her, but she scores heavily in being very well proportioned and sound. Excellent skull, would not like a longer muzzle. Excellent neck and forechest, very well angulated in front. Firm topline, deep chest. Excellent coat and colour. A sound and balanced mover from all angles. ***Reserve Best Bitch***

2. Sh.Ch. Tragus Honey Bee JW

An attractive bitch with a lovely attitude. Typical head with a pleasing skull and correct length of muzzle. Moderate neck. Firm topline. Unfortunately not in a good muscular condition and felt very soft to the touch. Still moved parallel coming and going, but not with enough power and strength from the side. Coat in between stages.
