PD (1) 1 Allison's Voroslang Harris Gold. Soundly made youngster. Good strength throughout for his age. Pleasing head, eye and expression. Well made front assembly along with a good width of hindquarters. Harsh coat and moved on a positive stride. Still very raw and needs to fill and drop in body to complete the picture, BP. **JD (2,1)** 1 Hamilton's Redrafi Mutai with Noreaster. Smart dog of good size and very well balanced. Strong quality bone along with a good wire coat. Typical in head with the best of expressions. Pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Good depth of chest, firm topline that he holds on the move and well rounded quarters with a good width of second thigh, A very sound mover with good reach and drive, Res.CC. **PGD (1)** 1 Moss's Ewtor Blue Moon. Pleasing sort of overall good make and shape. Liked his head piece, has a good eye and expression. Very clean over his neck and shoulders. Well boned, good ribbing, pleasing width of hindquarters and a good bend of stifle but is not exaggerated in anyway. Pleasing wire coat, moved on a good stride. Still needs to develop in chest to complete the picture. **LD (2)** 1 West's Junetta Erno. Good shape of correct proportions and presents a well balanced appearance. Sturdy throughout along with the best of coats. Pleasing head and eye. Strong muscular neck, good layback of shoulder, straight front and pleasing legs and feet. Firm back and a good tailset and carriage. Positive on the move, sound fore and aft. 2 Elders Enryb Pink Panther. Bigger framed dog who is built on clean lines and is well off for bone and substance but shows no sign of coarseness. Typical in head, well balanced and has a good eye and expression. Good depth of chest along with strong well muscled hindquarters. Moved soundly on a good stride. **OD (1)** 1 Moss's Sh.Ch.Ewtor Barking At The Moon JW. Liked him for his size and presents such a typical appearance, distinguished and robust as the standard asks for. Quality bone throughout and in the best of coats on the day. Good head, eye and expression. Very clean over the neck and shoulders. Well proportioned body, level topline with a good tailset and carriage. Good width of quarters. Sound on the move covering the ground on a good stride, CC & BOB. **PGB (3)** 1 Edminson's Kisdon Insignia. Built on clean lines with good bone and substance throughout but still keeps a feminine outlook. Clean cut head, well balanced and with that lively and intelligent expression the standard asks for. Pleasing reach of neck set in well placed shoulders. Shapely body, firm back and good strength of hindquarters. Moved well. 2 Lumasia's Redfari Zuri. Typy bitch, strongly built and presented on the day with a good wire coat. Pleasing head, good eye colour along with well set ears. Stands on good legs and feet, pleasing depth of chest, well ribbed and nicely rounded quarters. Sound on the move. 3 Garden's Leiborschy Theano. **LB (2)** 1 Cooper's Deifstock Dare To Dream JW. Good size, pleasing balance and proportions and quality bone throughout. Pleasing head piece. Well made front assembly, firm body with good depth. Correct tailset and carriage along with well angulated hindquarters but nothing exaggerated here. Moved on a good stride. 2 Hope-Cliffe & Hope-Ellershaw's Redrafi Pacha Galvikki. Well made and of pleasing confirmation throughout. Good eye and expression. Deep chest with plenty of heartroom, firm back and good width of quarters. Not the movement of the winner on the day. **OB (2,1)** 1 Byrne's Sh.Ch.Aldozovolgyi-Drotos Csermely at Enryb JW (IMP HUN). Good size, shape and balance. Good strength throughout and definitely looks like she could do a days work. Typical in head with the best of expressions. Clean front, good strength of neck and a shapely body. Best of hindquarters that she uses to advantage on the move. Covered the ground on a good stride, Res.CC.

VB (2) 1 Byrne's Aldo zovolgyi-Drotos Nyuzsgo at Enryb JW (IMP HUN). Has kept a very good shape both stacked and on the move. Excellent strength throughout. Medium sized as the standard asks for and soundly made. Good head piece. Clean over her neck and shoulders, good legs and feet, level back and a pleasing tailset and carriage. Strong quarters and well let down hocks. Soundest of movers with good reach and drive, CC. 2 Burke's Wychtrees Katia. Liked her size and overall appearance. Pleasing head, eye and expression. Well made front, strong neck set in well placed shoulders. Nicely ribbed, good depth and well rounded hindquarters of good width. Moved well on a pleasing stride.
